From the Mayor's Desk

At long last, the 6th Street Bridge replacement project is set to begin by the time you receive this newsletter! The contractor will set up construction signage and message boards regarding the road closure in late April, and expects to close the bridge by May 1 to begin preparation work. The demolition contractor is scheduled to remove the old bridge on Monday May 5th, with construction of the replacement bridge following immediately. We expect the 6th Street bridge to be closed through August.

Due to State and Federal waste water requirements the first phase of a waste water project is set to begin this summer. The first phase will upgrade and modernize the plant to improve system performance and reliability and to serve the City of Biggs for many years to come.

Weed Abatement

Weeds are growing early and fast this year. Tall weeds present a public nuisance for fire hazard and rodent harborage, not to mention visual blight. Please keep grass and weeds cut down on your property. Fines for uncut weeds identified as a nuisance code violation are \$100 for a first offense. Repeat offenders, property owners who are notified more than once a year, are subject to "frequent violator" fines of up to \$500 plus \$100 per day until the nuisance is abated.
