

City of Biggs Dog License Information

A City of Biggs dog license is the best identification your dog can wear. Licenses ensure quick identification and reunion if your dog becomes lost or missing without incurring fees for impoundment.

A dog license is required by California State Law and City of Biggs Ordinance No. 5.10.030:

- Within 30 days of acquiring a new dog or moving into the area
- When a puppy becomes four months of age

DOG LICENSE FEES

A current rabies certificate is required for licensing

License Period	Altered (Spayed/Neutered)	Unaltered (NOT Spayed/Neutered)
1 Year	\$6.00	\$12.00

- The rabies vaccine must be valid for the entire licensing period. A prorated license fee will be accepted to accommodate these instances. Please contact City Hall at 530-868-5493 for correct fee amount.
- Proof of spay/neuter is required.
